Comrades, Sisters and Brothers,

The Maryland General Assembly concluded its 2018 session and a few bills concerning veterans were passed. As must of you know, all of the veterans organizations have been fighting for

years for the passage of legislation that would exempt military retirement pay from the State income tax. Although our efforts were not entirely successful, this vear the legislature increased the amount of the retirement pay exempt from State Income tax to \$15,000 and reduced the age requirement from 65 to 55. Another bill gives a real property tax credit in Washington County to certain disabled veterans. HB 1162 and SB 0626 exempt surviving spouses of certain veterans from vehicle registration fees and SB 0362 does the same for certain disabled veterans. SB0429 and HB 0165 grant property tax credits to certain surviving spouses of veterans. Contact me if you have any questions about this legislation.

The deadline for submitting proposed amendments to the "Department and

National by-laws has passed and there were no proposed changes submitted. Looking forward to seeing you at the Department Convention in June.
