In order to qualify as an All State Post Commander and Quartermaster The following criteria *must* be accomplished:

- 1. Be 100% in Membership no later than June 30, 2019
- 2. The Post Quartermaster must be bonded
- 3. Post Commander, Sr Vice, Jr Vice, Quartermaster and Trustees must attend Department or a District OTI.
- 4. Post Commander, or Sr. Vice, or Jr Vice must attend "Recruiter Training"
- 5. The Post must be inspected and the Inspection Report received by the Department no later than December 31, 2018.
- 6. Submit <u>all</u> Post Audits as required by Section 218 of the National By-Laws and Manual of Procedure.
 - 1. Must have a **Completed Election** report on file and a **Completed Warrant** on file, indicating all officers have been properly installed
 - 2. Must submit at least 4 Community Activities Reports during the year, and must have received at least (1) credit in all (5) Community Activity categories.
- 7. Must submit a candidate for each mandatory program, Voice of Democracy, Patriot Pen and Teacher of the year. (Posts who don't have a candidate for Teacher of the year can make a donation to the Service Office)
- 8. Must submit a minimum of one entry from the Optional Program list:
 - Scout of The Year.
 - Law Enforcement Officer of The Year.
 - Firefighter of The Year.
 - Paramedic/EMT of The Year.
 - Student Veteran Activity Report.
- 10. Post Commander, or Sr. Vice or Jr. Vice must attend all District Meetings.
- 11. Each Post must perform and report a minimum of three (3) of the following VFW Commemorative Tributes and Ceremonies.

2018-2019 DISTRICT ALL STATE TEAM

REQUIREMENTS

In order to qualify as an All State District Commander and Quartermaster The following criteria <u>must</u> be accomplished:

- 1. Be 100% in Membership no later than June 30, 2019.
- 2. The District Quartermaster must be bonded.
- 3. All posts in the District must be inspected no later than November 30, 2018.
- 4. Each Post in District must Purchase Buddy Poppies.
- 5. *All* District quarterly audits must be submitted as required by Section 418 of the National By-Laws and Manual of Procedure.
- 6. Must have a **Completed Election** report on file and a **Competed Warrant** on file, indicating all officers have been properly installed.
- 7. All Posts in the District must be 100% reported in all programs. (Posts submitted at least 4 Community Activities Reports during the year, and must have received at least (1) credit in all (5) Community Activity categories)
- 8. The District must submit a candidate for the State Judging in Voice of Democracy, Patriot Pen and Teacher of the Year programs.
- 9. The District must submit at least One (1) from the Optional Program List:
 - Scout of The Year.
 - Law Enforcement Officer of the Year
 - Firefighter of the year.
 - Paramedic/EMT of the year.
- 10. The District must submit a Student Veteran Activity Report.
- 11. The District must have conducted at least six (6) District Meetings.
- 12. The District Commander, Sr. Vice <u>or</u> Jr. Vice must attend all Department Council of Administration Meetings.
- 13. The District must have conducted its own O.T.I. (including recruiter training) no later than September 30, 2019.
- 14. The District must make a donation to the Commanders Special Project.

DISTRICT ALL STATE TEAM AWARDS

- 1. All-State District Commanders and Quartermasters who have met all the criteria including 100% membership by April 30, 2019 will receive an All-State cap and lapel pin during the convention..
- 2. All-State District Commanders and Quartermasters meeting the criteria and 100% membership after April 30, 2019 and by June 30, 2019 will receive an All-State cap and lapel pin at a Council of Administration meeting.

50% Life Membership Discount Incentive Program

Program Goal:

- To increase Post Life Membership and convert existing annual members to life members.
- Free up efforts to recruit new members versus spending time chasing down existing members to pay annual dues.
- Increase life member rebates to Posts and Department

Program Parameters:

- Fifty (50) thousand dollars from the investment account to fund the program for a three
 (3) year period (or until funds are exhausted and not voted by the Council of Administration to be replaced)
- For any existing annual member of a Maryland Post or New Life Member joining a
 Maryland Post. The Department of Maryland will pay 50% of the member's life member's
 dues. This program is not available for reinstatements. Reinstatements must join a
 Maryland post first and be in good standing for two (2) years. This program also is not for
 At Large Members unless they join a Maryland post first and are members in good
 standing for two (2) years.
- This membership program is a great benefit and tool for recruiting new members as it shows a substantial savings over a period of years to younger members. Indicated below are the potential savings based on age Brackets.
